This year, in honor of the network's long-time informal lead, professor Vilhjálmur Árnason, we plan to have a special session on Wednesday morning dedicated to his work. Vilhjálmur's research has been wide-ranging, addressing the fundamentals of moral and political philosophy, as well as the more applied issues in philosophy of medicine and bioethics. We invite participants to submit abstracts addressing his work for this special session.

The workshop will be opened in the evening, August 22 (with an optional dinner) and closed after lunch on Wednesday, August 23, before the registration for the ESPMH conference.
